



LinkAbilities, a program of Gateways Community Services, is a nonprofit resource that promotes public and private partnerships to address workforce challenges for employers and people with disabilities in the Greater Nashua community.

LinkAbilities leads a coalition that includes businesses, community organizations, vendors, and people with disabilities. This coalition is developing a variety of sector-based training initiatives, school-to-work programs, and certification standards that will improve employment outcomes for individuals with disabilities and employers.

LinkAbilities expands the work force by connecting employers, job seekers with disabilities, and support services. We serve as a resource for the Greater Nashua area by forming unique community partnerships to provide training, guidance and information to fill employment gaps.

LinkAbilities is a program of *Gateways Community Services* funded by a grant from the Center for Medicaid and Medicare Services. LinkAbilities is also a lead agency of the Granite State Employment Project.

**Internship Description:** An intern would have the opportunity to work with partners from various organizations to help gather information that is relevant to community resource mapping. Ideally, one would work among various organizational staff members to map out potential community partnerships, discuss the range of services in the community and where the gaps are, and also the role of each agency in the community.

**Student Skills/Personal Attributes:** Knowledge of Word and Excel (or willingness to learn quickly) is a must. Must be comfortable working on projects independently, and have good communication skills. Person should be out-going, in order to initiate new contacts. Detail to information and data entry is a must.

**Seeking students majoring in or having an interest in:** Human Services (with a distinct interest in community organizing, policy and programmatic structure... i.e.: “macro”), Business (Sociology, Urban Planning) and/or Communications are encouraged to consider this position.
