As we move forward with our reopening efforts the health and safety of our staff, clients, and community will continue to guide our decisions. Governor Sununu lifted the state of NH Mask Mandate as of Friday April 16th but urged continued use of masks to prevent the spread of COVID-19. The lifting of this mandate does not prevent cities, towns, nor businesses from continuing to require masks.
